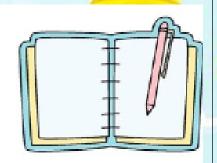

English: ACTIVITY – STORY WRITING

Imagine you are a weather reporter on a strange and magical island. One day, the weather starts to change in unusual ways. Write a story about your adventure as you discover what is causing the weather changes and how you work to restore balance in the island. Draw or paint illustrations of the magical weather and the creatures you encounter during your journey.

<u>CREATIVE ELEMENTS:</u> Use Your imagination to describe the island, weather phenomena, and creatures in the story. They can describe a storm made of colors, winds that whisper, or animals that are affected by the weather changes.

ART ELEMENT: Students are required to create at least two drawings or paintings of scenes from their story: One could be an illustration of the magical weather—such as a glowing rainstorm, a rainbow-colored thundercloud, or a sunset that never fades. Another could show a creature or magical element they encounter during their adventure, like a weather spirit, a mystical animal, or an enchanted tree.

COMPREHENSION SEASONS AROUND US

Weather and climate are important parts of our environment. Weather tells us what the sky and air are like each day. It may be sunny, rainy, windy, or cloudy. Weather can change quickly, even in one day. Climate is the usual weather of a place over many years. For example, deserts have a hot and dry climate, while mountains have a cold climate. Climate does not change quickly. Weather and climate help us decide what clothes to wear and what crops to grow. Knowing about them helps us stay safe and plan better.
